## This Week's Message from Father Martel

### Dear Parish Community,

In today's Gospel, Jesus speaks about the servant whom the master finds vigilant and faithful upon his return. He tells the parable of the steward who is entrusted with responsibility — not just to hold things in place, but to care for others with wisdom, consistency, and integrity. "Blessed is that servant whom his master finds faithful and prudent," Jesus says.

This parable reminds us that stewardship is not only about resources — it's about trust. God entrusts each of us with something: our time, our gifts, our families, and our faith. And He asks us to care for them not as owners, but as faithful stewards — watchful, responsible, and generous.

At St. Joseph's Church, I see this kind of faithful stewardship lived out every day. Parishioners serve quietly and generously through our liturgies — as **altar servers, lectors, communion ministers, ushers, choir members, and the hospitality group** — and through our outreach ministry, especially the Food Pantry volunteers, who dedicate

themselves to picking up, unloading, and **organizing** donated food for our Hispanic community and other individuals and families in need. I am also grateful to our **Parish Finance Council members**, who, whether the matter is large or small, are always ready to assist me and offer sound guidance. Their support has been a true blessing.

I invite others to consider becoming more involved in parish life. There is always something to do when it is for God and the Church.

In the coming weeks, we will also begin forming our **Parish Pastoral Council**. It is my hope that together, with prayerful discernment and shared commitment, we can continue to strengthen the mission of our parish.

Let us continue to pray that the Lord finds us faithful in the responsibilities He has given us — as individuals, and as a parish family.
